

## RECORD RESULTS AT RUPLASTICA, UPAKEXPO AND RECYCLING SOLUTIONS 2025

From January 21 to 24, the Expocentre Fairgrounds hosted the largest international specialized exhibitions of plastics and rubbers **RUPLASTICA**, packaging, printing and filling technologies **UPAKEXPO**, waste management and plastics recycling **RECYCLING SOLUTIONS**, as well as a specialized project in the field of 3D printing technologies in production **ADDITIVE MINDED**.

In search of new partnerships, contacts, knowledge, product and technological solutions, the platform was visited by **33,000 specialists**, and **over 1,000 companies, from more than 20 countries** took part in the projects. Among them are Russia, Türkiye, Iran, China, UAE, Brazil, San Marino, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, India, Egypt, Italy, Germany, Taiwan, Belarus and others.

The exhibitions of 2025 showed unprecedented interest from domestic and international companies in working on the Russian market. Many participants presented their products for the first time – thus, visitors had the opportunity to meet new suppliers from Russia, the CIS countries, Asia and the Middle East.

Achieving technological sovereignty and a new vector of movement to the East are the economic trends that have already gained momentum, and within the framework of the exhibition projects **RUPLASTICA**, **UPAKEXPO** and **RECYCLING SOLUTIONS** they have acquired their own industry specifics, and have also been supplemented by global tasks, such as ecology, efficient use of resources and new technological achievements.

Among the foreign exhibitors, the most widely represented companies were from **China, Turkey, India** and **Iran**. Firms **with European roots**, firmly established in the Russian market, and of course **key domestic manufacturers** of products in all areas, also continued their work.

**The special exposition "Moulds and Dies"** continued its rapid development, where more than 100 companies presented forming tools. Molds are always in demand, since they are responsible for the final

appearance of the product, but at the same time they are one of the most difficult stages for each manufacturer - a lot of joint work is required between the customer and the manufacturer to get the desired result. Thus, the development of this segment in the concept of exhibitions once again confirms its global goal - in search of a suitable offer, you do not need to travel across the country and other countries - mold manufacturers present their capabilities to customers in Moscow at the alliance exhibitions.



The large-scale business program included the work of five streams: the polymer industry forum **POLYMER PLAZA**, the discussion platform for the packaging and printing industry **INNOVATION PACK**, the conference on the economics of reproduction, recycling and disposal **RECYCLING SOLUTIONS**, as well as expert sessions on industrial 3D printing **ADDITIVE MINDED** and the III International Polymer Hackathon in the discipline "Chemistry and Physics of Polymers" for final-year students of universities.

Over the course of 4 days of a busy program, guests of **RUPLASTICA**, **UPAKEXPO** and **RECYCLING SOLUTIONS** exhibitions were able to get acquainted with all the key trends and tendencies of various segments of the polymer, packaging, processing and 3D technology industries, personally communicate with dozens of authoritative experts and top executives of leading market companies, and also replenish the baggage of business solutions and technologies for their own business.
